



# Could Lang Syne Reverend Edward Dunn

We sing "auld lang syne" to mark the end of the year on New Year's Eve. The words, penned by Robert Burns who is recognized as the national poet of Scotland, are loosely translated "for the sake of old times." A later poet, Matthew Fitt, has used the same phrase as a way to begin a retelling of fairy tales. To him, the phrase "in the days of auld lang syne" capture the words most likely known to us, "once upon a time."

December 2023 marks the beginning of a new liturgical year with the season of Advent. These four weeks, including the morning of December 24 will focus on the preparation of God's people for a coming Messiah. Our telling of the story of Christmas in Luke's gospel begins with time, "In those days a decree went out from Emperor Augustus..." Our hearing of this story is very much "in the days of auld lang syne."

This edition of the Grapevine celebrates much of what we have been doing and what we are continuing to do as a church. It is also an edition of auld lang syne, since in mid December we officially become United Presbyterian Church. The stories of Palma Sola and Westminster, already intertwined with one another over the past three years, will continue as the story of a new congregation. 

## December Outreach Update

It is hard to believe the year is almost over, but what a year it has been! You have worked together to reach out with love and service in so many ways, and we look forward with gratitude to all the things we can accomplish as **United Presbyterian Church** in the future.

#### **November Outreach Highlights:**

- You shopped for and filled over **50 wrapped shoes boxes** to help provide gifts to seniors served by **Meals on Wheels** this Christmas.
- You generously gave monetary contributions to **Presbyterian Disaster Assistance**. \$500 from budgeted funds was added to October and November collections to make an even bigger impact.
- Folks volunteered every Friday at Our Daily Bread.
- You contributed \$750 from budgeted funds to support providing weekend backpacks of food for children through the **Feeding Empty Little Tummies** program.
- You made an additional **400 PB & J sandwiches** that were delivered to clients in need at **Our Daily Bread for a total of 6400 sandwiches** since the beginning of this ministry.
- You sent extra donations of \$300 each to help offset day-to-day expenses at Our Daily Bread, Salvation Army, Mision Peniel, Beth-El Farmworker Ministry, Cedarkirk Camp & Conference Center, and Christian Care Alliance. These gifts go a long way to provide assistance to those served by these wonderful organizations.
- You helped weed, mulch, plant and trim to improve the church grounds prior to the holiday season.
- You lovingly donated to the **Salvation Army Angel Tree** to help buy Christmas gifts for those "angels" not previously selected from the tree.
- You purchased bags and gift cards for **Manatee Operation Troop Support** to provide gifts to local military families this Christmas.

#### **December Outreach Opportunities:**

- Our **DOES It** (**Done On Every Sunday**) project for December is making **12 Days of Christmas food gifts bags to donate to those in need.** Pick up a large fabric reusable grocery bag and place the following items in it, item by item each day as you give thanks to God for your own blessings:
- Day 1 jar of peanut butter | Day 2 jar of jelly | Day 3 box of pasta
- Day 4 jar of spaghetti sauce | Day 5 can of corn | Day 6 can of green beans
- Day 7 box of mac 'n' cheese | Day 8 box of cereal | Day 9 2 lb. bag of rice
- Day 10 can of soup | Day 11 can of chicken or tuna | Day 12 roll of toilet tissue & a bar of soap
- Return your bags to the Narthex or church office by **December 24th**. Filled bags will be taken to Our Daily Bread for distribution through the Loaves and Fishes food pantry.


