Moving Forward Reverend Edward Dunn

I am pleased to share that our work at merging the congregations of Westminster and Palma Sola is in progress. You'll recall that in our December/January Grapevine I wrote about the deliberate pacing required to successfully merge churches: our progress remains on track.

A Joint Merger Committee representing both congregations has been created and held its first meeting on Tuesday, January 17. Representing the Westminster congregation are Dick Haynes, Sherri Kramer, and John Progar. Representing the Palma Sola congregation are Vicki Schooley, Roy Williams, and Rich Wachunis.

Peace River Presbytery will be our partner in completing the merger of the churches. The Book of Order places authority for merging churches in the hands of the presbytery. The Committee on Ministry has approved our request that the presbytery work with us in merging, and the presbytery will receive and vote on the creation of an Administrative Commission at its meeting on March 2nd. Included in the work of the Joint Merger Committee and Administrative Commission are Adaptive tasks (considering the mission and vision of the newly formed church) and Technical tasks (determining the details – legal, financial, and ecclesial - and the policies of a united church).

There will also be opportunities for your input. One of the most significant decisions to make will be the name of a new congregation. Members will have the chance to suggest names and a process for deciding a final name will involve you too.

Please keep everyone who will be working on this important project in your prayers.

December Meeting

• Expressed appreciation for the service of Elder Lesch, who is retiring at year-end after completing her second two-year term.

• Welcomed Elder-elect Andrea Harmon, who will serve as Chair of the Releasing Team (Outreach & Missions).

• Recorded standing orders for scheduling communion and collecting offerings for the ministry.

• Scheduled the 2022 Annual Meeting of the congregation following worship on Sunday, February 19th.

• Approved establishing the position of Graphic Design Specialist, to be filled by Faraja Keyes as an Independent Contractor for 2023. An employment agreement was reviewed and executed.

• In its capacity as Trustees of Palma Sola Presbyterian Church, Inc., Session elected the following Officers of the Corporation for 2023: Ron Dickerson-President, Andrea Harmon-Vice-President, Roy Williams-Secretary/Treasurer, Gail Dickerson-Director and Gregg Pead-Director & Registered Agent.

• Roy Williams was elected Clerk of Session for 2023.

• Reviewed and approved the 2023 Operating Budget. Based on an income estimate of \$292,720, and expenses projected to be \$319,419, the Budget would have a deficit of \$26,699.

• Approved the Installation Service for all new church Officers will be held on January 8th.

• Announced the following appointments to a Joint Merger Steering Committee: Vicki Schooley, Rich Wachunis and Roy Williams from Palma Sola, and Dick Haynes, Sherri Kramer and John Progar from Westminster. In conjunction with an Administrative Commission to be elected by the Presbytery, this group will be responsible for dealing with the many details of the church merger.





KAIROS UPDATE

On January 7th and 8th, 10 Kairos volunteers entered Hardee Correctional Institution to fellowship, listen and reinforce the presence and love of Jesus. This retreat was for inmates that had previously attended a four-day Kairos weekend. We ministered to over 100 men-in-blue (inmates).

The Max Lucado DVD series "You are Not Alone" was used as the introduction to a series of small group discussions. These discussions, while started by a Kairos volunteer, had a life of their own with each small group of residents focusing on what touched their hearts. After the small group discussions, a representative from each group presented a summary of their group's discussion to all Kairos attendees. Discussions included topics of "What caused you to believe in Jesus?", "Miracles by Jesus.", The significance of "I AM"., the significance of the Greek word "tetelestai", and finally their thoughts on death. Many of the men realize that prison is where they will die.

Thank you to those that baked cookies. The men-in-blue truly look forward to them. Yes, the taste is important, but also important to them is knowing that someone outside the wire and walls thinks of them. February Outreach Update

February is the month of love and a perfect time to remind everyone the various ways you reached out and shared the love of Christ with others in the past year. The Westminster and Palma Sola congregations gave a total of **\$80,671** to our local and international communities in 2022! This doesn't even include all the donations of food, clothing, school supplies, time, and talents you have so generously given. That is definitely **love IN DEED**! Please take a moment to check out the thank you notes posted in Fellowship Hall from many of our grateful recipients.

Recap of end of year and January events:

• A total of **\$910 was collected for the Salvation Army Angel Tre**e to purchase Christmas gifts for local children.

• \$457 was collected for Presbyterian Mission Agency's Christmas Joy Offering.

- About **30 boxes and bags of non-perishable food items** (2 carloads full!) were donated to the food pantry at Our Daily Bread from our December 12 Days of Christmas collection.
- From the proceeds of our Cookie Exchange, we were able to help purchase over **300 pairs of socks** that were gifted to clients of Our Daily Bread on Christmas Eve.
- We provided **Christmas gifts for 17 residents** of the Brookdale Bayshore Gardens Assisted Living Facility who would otherwise not have received any gifts this year.
- As part of our **PB & J Sandwich Ministry** we have made and donated over **2000 sandwiches** since September to Our Daily Bread.
- Proceeds of the **Dreyer Trust** blessed nearly 40 families with the gift of assistance, helping with the costs of healthcare, utilities and rent for a total of **\$40,480** for the year.
- Provided home baked cookies for the Kairos Prison Ministry Retreat at the Hardee Correctional Institute. Over 100 inmates participated in this weekend conversation and study centered around Max Lucado's "You Are Never Alone" series.
- During our January **Undie Sundays**, we collected **hundreds** of underwear for men and women to benefit the clothes closet at **Turning Points**.
