a Gear In Review Reverend Edward Dunn

Many of us will receive at least one Christmas card that, in addition to a holiday greeting, includes a letter describing how the year has been. The missive describes the high points in family members' lives and may speak briefly about the challenges and heartaches as well. Family vacations, births and graduations, marriages and school achievements are always welcome news to read about. The death of a loved one, the loss of a job, or a move far from family and home may move us to tears. These letters or notes are an invitation into the life of a family; they serve as a reminder of the special connection we have with the author and their loved ones.

As we near the end of 2024, our church celebrates its first anniversary under the name, United Presbyterian Church. It seems strange to call something a first anniversary when the connection between us has been in place for nearly five years. The relationship begun by Palma Sola and Westminster in 2020 has grown stronger because you were willing to take on the goal of becoming one congregation. It is my privilege as your pastor to shepherd the two churches into the reality of being a single congregation – united by our love of God and each other – and declared to the community by the choice of our name – United Presbyterian Church.

There has been much to celebrate this year. The official merger of the churches in December 2024. The beginning of new opportunities for learning: our Present Word Class on Sundays and special classes including the Mayberry Bible Study and our summer Between Sundays series. The joy in our labor as we have now made more than 10,000 peanut butter and jelly sandwiches for Our Daily Bread diners. The planning for a new holiday season event – Candy Cane Carnival – for Palma Sola Elementary students and families on December 14th . The sharing of talents from our Chancel and Bell Choirs and our Praise Band in worship. The offering of Drive Thru Ashes on Ash Wednesday was certainly a different practice for some and a welcome opportunity for the drivers and those who stopped by at the beginning of Lent.

The year has not been without its heartaches for our congregation. Our All Saints worship service commemorated the passing of seven members. We said goodbye to other members who have moved from the area to be closer to family. We are in prayer for others who because of health matters are no longer able to join us in worship each week. We are saddened by these losses and changes to our congregation's life but we give thanks to God for the sure and certain hope of the resurrection and the assurance that nothing can separate us from God's love in Jesus Christ.

Our program year for 2025 is A Season of Possibilities. The Session has begun consideration of the input provided my members during our Ministry Fair event. We will be exploring areas where God has already called us to mission; and keeping our eyes, ears, and hearts open to new occasions and possibilities that God has in store. One of these new possibilities in a deepening relationship with the staff, children, and families of Palma Sola Elementary. We are now a community partner with the school which will allow us to join in activities and share in promotion of our church to those families. I believe that our Season of Possibilities includes growing in our connection with families in our neighborhood. This will require some new thinking and may call us to re-learn and re-live our past connections. I'm eager to discover what else is in store for us.

So, as one year ends and a new one begins, this is my review of the year. It's not thorough nor complete but is meant to inspire you to recall other blessings we have received and ways we can become a blessing to others in the future.

November Session Highlights

- Endorsed resumption of 'between the Sundays' Bible Study on Wednesdays in December to explore the Advent messages in depth.

It is hard to believe the year is almost over, but what a year it has been! You have worked together to reach out with love and service in so many ways, and we look forward with gratitude to all the things we can accomplish as **Únited Presbyterian Church** in the future.

November Outreach Highlights:

- You generously gave monetary contributions to Presbyterian Disaster Assistance to help with hurricane recovery and other crisis around the world.
- Folks volunteered every Friday at Our Daily Bread.
- You wrote letters to 2nd graders as part of our Pen Pal Program with Palma Sola Elementary School.
- You shopped for and filled over 50 wrapped shoe boxes to help provide gifts to seniors served by Meals on Wheels this Christmas.
- You made an additional 400 PB&J sandwiches that helped feed hungry clients of Our Daily Bread in Bradenton.
- You lovingly donated to the Salvation Army Angel Tree to help buy Christmas gifts for those "angels" not previously selected from the tree. \$348 of our budget from the Marshall Fund was added to make an even bigger impact.
- You reached out to our neighborhood families by participating in Palma Sola Elementary's Harvest Roundup. UPC provided a lollipop ring toss game and volunteers shared information about our church with parents and children. It was a lot of fun for all involved!


