




February Session Highlights

Earth Care: United Presbyterian Is Having a Positive Impact

In February, we applied for PC(USA) Earth Care Congregation recertification with >3 times the number of scorecard points required.

After installing 2 new high-efficiency HVAC systems last September, our electricity use declined 22.5% in the first 4 months compared with those same months a year earlier.

We can save even more electricity when we turn out lights in empty rooms that have the reminder signs shown in the photo. Keep a lookout!

Our earth-care Community Engagement Advisory Team focuses on ways our church can participate in local earth care. Here's an opportunity for each of us:



Emerson Point Expansion Purchase. The Manatee County Environmental Land Acquisition Committee (ELMAC) is trying to move along the purchase of 97 acres to expand Emerson Point Preserve, in the wings for nearly 30 years. It is going to the Board of County Commissioners for approval in March, but it appears there are efforts to jeopardize the deal.

Once purchased, the State of Florida will purchase the extension from Manatee County at the appraised value. Any difference will be paid by the Save Water and Land Referendum Funds that 70% of voters passed in 2020.
