Building on last September's Ministry Fair event, A Season of Possibilities, the Session has been in conversation about the comments and observations shared by our congregation. I am grateful to those who shared insights with us about the life, ministry, and image of United Presbyterian Church.

A new and great adventure for us is beginning as we learn what it means to be a "Sailboat" church. The idea of being a sailboat church contrasts with the practice in many congregations of being a "Rowboat." We are using the resources of the Presbyterian Foundation's Project Regeneration and the book Sailboat Church by Joan Gray, to help us realize that God's intention for us is to be led by the winds of the spirit, rather than being propelled and driven by our own efforts at rowing.

Like most adventures there are new things to learn and at time, things to unlearn. We, like most churches, have existed as if the work of God's kingdom and mission depended entirely and exclusively on how hard we rowed and how many people were pulling the oars.

In a new era we recognize that those who have been rowing for a long time are weary or don't have the ability to row as hard as they once did. This makes us prone to despair and want to give up altogether.

Our recent meetings with Dana Waters, our regional representative from the Presbyterian Foundation, now include a forty day period of prayer and discernment. We have multiple options available and choices to make; more on these later! I ask that you include in your own prayers, the movement of the winds of the spirit in our leaders and Elders during this time of prayer.

How will this effort play out? None of us knows but in this season and in the month in which we celebrate new life and Jesus' victory over the power of death, I hope we will allow hope and resurrection overshadow fear and skepticism.

You will also play a part in Project Regeneration. Initial plans include opportunities to read Sailboat Church or to participate in a read-along. An opportunity for members and friends to join in season of prayer and discernment will follow; and in due time, a town hall gathering will be a time to share what you have learned and felt the Spirit blowing in our church.

I encourage you to participate fully or as you are able in our Easter services: our Palm/Passion Sunday in which we hear the story of Jesus' passion; join in our Maundy Thursday dinner and service on April 17; and attend our Easter services at Palma Sola Botanical Park at 7a.m. and/or our sanctuary service at 10a.m. on April 20.

I am excited to lead and join with you in this new adventure in the Spirit.







April Session Highlights

Your contributions, through your pledges, outreach offering and donating underwear for the clients of Our Daily Bread reflect your outreach to your community and beyond this past month. Thank you for your gifts.

February Outreach Highlights:

- Plastic cups were purchased with budgeted funds for Our Daily Bread.
- Desperately needed styrofoam coffee cups (approximately 400) no longer used at the church, plus coffee and creamer purchased from the budget account Community Outreach were donated to Turning Points.
- Items for the Blessing Box are being purchased monthly with funds collected from the 3 Cents A Meal and Scottish Sunday donations.
- You've donated underwear for the clients of Turning Points.
- Our Outreach offering for Our Daily Bread was \$915 at the end of February.
- March total is not yet available. Thank you for your generosity.
- Another 100 peanut butter and jelly sandwiches were made and donated to Our Daily Bread.
- Volunteers faithfully served every Friday at Our Daily Bread.
- A chilly wagon train tour of Duette Preserve was enjoyed by 20 of our members on March 6th.
- A few folks showed up to plant new plants and landscape around fellowship hall on Saturday, March 8th. Thanks, it looks great!
- All the egg cartons you donated in February, along with leftover flatware and Dorcus fabric will be delivered to Mision Peniel in early April.
- The Dreyer Trust disbursements at the end of February are \$4005.
- We have been re-certified as an Earth Care Congregation.
- A few of us attended the S.T.R.E.A.M. rally day on March 3rd and learned of the recent progress and planned requests for our community leaders in the areas of Affordable housing, and youth mental health. Many are expected to attend the Nehemiah action event on March 31st to support the requests and hear the response of our community leaders.

Our Spring Member's Work Day: Saturday, April 5th | 8:00 AM.




