This month's Grapevine is a double edition; July and August: months that are somewhat slower paced in the church. Things will be slower but they will not stop. Please note that the Present Word class and Fellowship Hour activities will not be held during July. They will resume in August.

II. We are in the midst of a sermon series, Boating Season, in which we are reading and considering Biblical stories of boats, sailing, and discipleship. Our Between Sunday classes are reading and discussing these passages with a little more depth on Wednesdays at 10:30a.m. The idea for this series was sparked by the leadership's reading of the book, Sailboat Church by Joan Gray. I recommend it to you if you are interested or willing to become involved in our discerning about our church's future.

III. In late August my Doctor of Ministry classes through Duke University's Divinity School will begin with an Orientation and Immersion Week from August 21-29. I am excited by the opportunity to study and learn new things in the practice of ministry from the faculty and the cohort of ministers with whom I will be working.

The majority of my studies will be conducted on-line, with residential Immersion weeks in August, January, and May through 2027, followed by a writing term in which I will complete my dissertation/project, and Lord willing, graduation in 2028.

The benefit of a D. Min program is that the pastor continues to work in their ministry while attending school. It does add a bit more to the weekly schedule but should not affect the work needed to be done in the local congregation.

I am grateful to the Session and leaders of Westminster and United for their financial support, and to the members and friends who have and will offer prayers and words of encouragement as this work begins.

I hope that you are all enjoying your summer. Whereas it is time to relax and enjoy a slower schedule, our community needs continue. In particular, let's not forget Feeding Empty Little Tummies, funding children who may not have school breakfast or lunch this summer. Families continue to be hungry, so please donate non-perishable food items to the barrels in the Narthex and monetary contributions to the Food Bank of Manatee County.

June Outreach Highlights:

- The Dreyer Trust disbursement through May was \$18,692. The Dreyer Trust funds one time medical, rent, food, etc. emergency needs for those who submit requests through the Christian Care Alliance.
- You continue to donate food and supply funds through our budget for food items for the Blessing Box.
- Donations of food (DOES IT) and money (June Outreach Offering) have been made for the Food Bank of Manatee County.
- A donation to Mision Peniel of \$500, through our budget, was made to purchase backpacks for school children.
- Volunteers have stepped up to serve at Our Daily Bread on Fridays.
- A donation of \$240 to the West Manatee Fire and Rescue to provide 15 children with fire prevention books and information has been made.

June Session Highlights




